

Organizing Guidelines for Overseas Chinese Admission to Graduate Programs Reviewing Committee, College of Humanities, NKTU

Effective upon endorsement by the President on May 12, 1996

1. The NKTU College of Humanities Overseas Chinese Admission to Graduate Programs Reviewing Committee (hereafter This Committee) has been set up according to Article 4 of "NKTU Overseas Chinese Admission to Graduate Programs Reviewing Guidelines."
2. The function of This Committee is to review cases of overseas Chinese' admission to graduate programs approved by departments or institutes in this College.
3. The members of This Committee are the Dean and Department or Institute Chairpersons. The Dean is the convener. Each member's term is one year. Each member's right is valid until the date when members of the next term are appointed.
4. A meeting held by This Committee is valid only when one-half of all the members attend. Consensus will not be reached unless one-half of the attending members agree.
5. This Committee finishes reviewing the data submitted by departments or institutes by June 15 each year and refers the reviewed list and data to the Office of Academic Affairs.
6. If there is something left unspecified in these guidelines, related regulations of NKTU should be applied.
7. These guidelines are effective having been endorsed by the President. Revision follows the same procedure.
