

Organizing Guidelines for Faculty Reviewing Committee, College of Humanities, NKNU

approved by the Fifth Administrative Meeting of the
1996 Academic Year, January 8, 1997

1. The NKNU College of Humanities Faculty Reviewing Committee (hereafter This Committee) has been set up according to "University Law." Section 1, Article 31 of "NKNU Organizational System Rules" in order to review the personnel cases about faculty members' initial employment, term of employment, promotion, employment suspension, dismissal, and others.
2. The permanent members of This Committee are the Dean and Department or Institute Chairpersons. The other members are full professors (if unavailable, associate professors) representing departments or institutes, one from each. The Dean is the Chair of This Committee. Each member's term is one year and should not be renewed. Each member's right is valid until the date when members of the next term are appointed.
3. This Committee reviews initial employment, term of employment, promotion, employment suspension, dismissal and other personnel cases of full-time and part-time faculty members.
4. This Committee holds meetings irregularly. A meeting is valid only when two-thirds of all the members attend. If a case under review can not get a consensus, an anonymous vote is held. Two-thirds of attending members voting in favor means approval.
5. Recommendation cases reviewed and approved by This Committee should be referred to the NKNU Faculty Reviewing Committee.
6. These guidelines are effective having been approved by College of Humanities Meeting and NKNU Administrative Meeting, and endorsed by the President. Revision follows the same procedure.
