

Organizing Guidelines for Curriculum Reviewing Committee, College of Humanities, NKNU

approved by the First Ad-Hoc College of Humanities Meeting of the Second Semester of the
1995 Academic Year, March 3, 1996

1. The NKNU College of Humanities Curriculum Reviewing Committee (hereafter This Committee) has been set up according to Section 2, Article 31 of "NKNU Organizational System Rules."
2. The function of This Committee is to discuss, review courses related to this College and course offering.
3. The permanent members of This Committee are the Dean and Department or Institute Chairpersons. The other members are representatives from departments or institutes, one from each. The Dean is the convener. Each member's term is one year.
4. A meeting held by This Committee is valid only when one-half of all the members attend. Consensus will not be reached unless one-half of the attending members agree.
5. Consensus reached in This Committee should be referred to the NKNU Curriculum Reviewing Committee.
6. This Committee holds meetings at least once each semester; ad-hoc meetings, if necessary.
7. These guidelines are effective having been approved by College of Humanities Meeting and endorsed by the President. Revision follows the same procedure.
