Dr Wang is an IB Program Leader for Diploma program (DP) evaluation, an IB School visit team leader, and a consultant for IB school authorization. She also serves as a visiting committee member of the Accrediting Commission for Schools & Western Association of Schools and Colleges. At the same time, Dr Wang became an adjunct assistant professor at the Graduate Institute of Teaching Chinese as a Second/Foreign Language of the National Kaohsiung Normal University after retiring from her leadership roles in international school settings.
